Together, we will change our future and our children's future, and restore America to its constitutional roots.

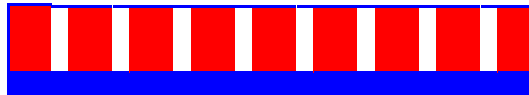

We are deeply concerned about the SCOPE of GOVERNMENT:

- Progressive politicians pervert the U.S. Constitution's "General Welfare" clause.
- One-world government is not acceptable.
- Our Constitution reserves most rights for the states (states' rights) and limits government, not citizens.
- Separation of powers mandates citizen oversight.
- Freedom demands vigilance of citizens, and a fair and balanced free press.
- We are a Christian nation: Our Constitution and Bill of Rights are based on Christian principles.
- Separation of church and state does not mean removing Christianity from our country.

We are deeply worried about OUR ECONOMY:

- Fiscal responsibility = balanced budgets (government cost estimates have never been accurate!).

- Social Security and Medicare (unconstitutional programs) costs are terminal.
- Government action caused current recession.
- Tax rate cuts increase economic activity and income to the U.S. Treasury

On Health Care:
